About this role

Moonshot is seeking an Information Security Manager to take day-to-day responsibility for organisational digital and physical security. Your role will be to lead the development and implementation of security policies and processes, including proactive horizon scanning, and capacity building across the team. You will also provide security-relevant input into project design, delivery and business development. This position reports into the Director of Operations, and is supported by the Office Manager.

Responsibilities will include:

Threat modelling, monitoring and response:

- Lead on the development and implementation of digital and physical security practices across all Moonshot offices;
- Develop and maintain an internal compliance system, including regular and ad hoc internal tests of digital security;
- Update and maintain digital security policies in compliance with relevant accreditations and international best practices;
- Work with the Operations and Projects teams to ensure policies and processes are responsive to staff and project needs;
- Lead on internal threat monitoring for the purposes of staff safety;
- Respond to digital security threats, including threat analysis, crisis / incident response, risk mitigation and maintain logs of security breaches;
- Oversee the development and maintenance of personal safety plans for team members;
- Maintain awareness of global security breaches and international / industry best practices for ongoing development of internal processes;
- Work with the Programmes Team to develop enhanced digital security infrastructure and processes for high-risk work, including CSEA;
- Develop and maintain digital business continuity plans, including alternative service providers for business critical software and apps;
- Oversee travel security in tandem with programme teams.

Training and internal communications:

- Lead on onboarding and ongoing digital and physical security training for all Moonshot staff and consultants;
- Provide regular updates to the team on new policy / guidance;
- Act as a key point of contact for staff on digital and physical security.

Infrastructure:

- Oversee information security across the organisation, working closely with the Data Protection Officers to ensure GDPR compliance;
- Assess current IT infrastructure, developing a roadmap to improve quality and scale in line with Moonshot's global growth;
- Monitor systems for emerging security gaps and oversee implementation of effective solutions;
- Ensure secure maintenance of Moonshot websites and domains;

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- Manage access rights for employees and consultants;
- Ensure consistent reviews / vetting of all new software and manage the approvals process in tandem with Programme Teams;
- Liaise with external providers on the maintenance of digital infrastructure;
- Support Moonshot's Tech Team on secure access to internal tools and platforms;
- Maintain security accreditations (ISO, CyberEssentials Plus) and oversee internal audit processes.

Requirements:

- Demonstrated ability to manage security of operations for sensitive and complex global work;
- Demonstrated ability to assess and manage risk;
- Experience in implementing new digital and physical security approaches to increase capacity, agility and safety across teams;
- Experience managing cloud-based infrastructure across a global organisation;
- Experience evaluating software applications and other security solutions;
- Experience in designing and managing effective security systems, processes and policies;
- Understanding of key information security accreditations such as ISO27001 and CyberEssentials Plus;
- Highly trustworthy, demonstrating the ability to use appropriate discretion in supporting the organisation and its employees;
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, including the ability to work with patience and empathy, and tailor communications to different levels of knowledge / experience;
- Highly organised, with the ability to prioritise between various competing priorities while maintaining an attention to detail;
- A commitment to Moonshot's mission and ethos;
- Candidates will be expected to undertake and pass a DBS checks, vetting and any relevant security clearance procedures and DBS checks per the needs of clients.

Desirable:

- Experience with a growing organisation, setting up in new geographies, and managing security framework across locations;
- Experience with US and / or UK government contracting requirements, or other government procurement processes.
