# Operations & Security Manager

Moonshot believes that marginalized people in society — including minority ethnic people, people from working class backgrounds, women, Disabled and LGBTQIA+ people — must be centered in the work we do. We strongly encourage applications from people with these identities or who are members of other communities who are currently underrepresented in our workforce. We know a diverse workforce will enable us to understand drivers behind violent extremism and online harms in an in-depth way and do better work to counter them.

## About this role

Moonshot, an organization established in the UK to end online harms, is currently establishing its first US office in Washington D.C. We are hiring an Operations and Security Manager as one of the first members of this team, who will lead on all aspects of operations in the US and security globally. It is an exciting opportunity to join a growing international team, and help to build the US operations from the ground up. This role will be responsible for setting up and running the D.C. office, US-based operations, and global digital and physical security. This role will report into the Director of Operations based in London and is supported by the UK Office Manager.

## Responsibilities will include:

### Operations Management:

- Overseeing and coordinating the set-up of the Moonshot Washington D.C. office, including office space design and fit out, establishment of operational processes, creation of US operational policies, and design and implementation of necessary office functions.
- Ensuring the smooth day-to-day running of the office, including data management and IT systems, office supplies, financial management of office expenses, vendor and building management relationships, workplace safety.
- General support to the wider team, including authorizing and processing travel bookings, couriers, mailings and meeting logistics.
- Assistance with US human resources processes, including recruitment, pre-employment checks and on-boarding.

### Security Management:

- Overseeing digital and physical security for Moonshot globally, across its US, UK and Ireland offices.
- Acting as relationship owner with all security-related vendors, including contract management and escalation of issues.
- Conducting regular reviews of vendor performance and cost effectiveness, and fit for changing organizational needs.
- Owning the security risk register, maintaining a log of security breaches and promoting a culture of security within the organization, including through training and awareness raising activities.
- Owning the internal compliance system, including regular and ad hoc tests of digital security, managing access controls, and working in partnership with the Compliance Manager to ensure digital security meets our data management needs.
- Owning and developing digital and physical security policies, ensuring they keep pace with industry standards and best practices, and working closely with project teams to ensure they are fit for purpose. Also overseeing business continuity as it relates to digital and physical security.
- Overseeing physical security, including work spaces, working closely with the UK-based Office Manager, personnel safety via threat monitoring, and travel safety.
- Maintaining Moonshot websites and domains.
- Supporting the Moonshot Tech Team on secure access to internal tools and platforms.
- Maintaining security accreditations (ISO, CyberEssentials Plus) and overseeing internal audit processes.

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## Requirements:

### Essential:

- Demonstrated ability to manage security of operations for sensitive and complex global work.
- Experience in selecting vendors and managing vendor relationships.
- Experience of working autonomously.
- Demonstrated ability to assess and manage risk.
- Experience in implementing new digital and physical security approaches to increase capacity, agility and safety across teams.
- Experience managing cloud-based infrastructure across a global organization.
- Experience evaluating software applications and other security solutions.
- Experience in designing and managing effective security systems, processes and policies.
- Highly trustworthy, demonstrating the ability to use appropriate discretion in supporting the organization and its employees.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, including the ability to work with patience and empathy, and tailor communications to different levels of knowledge / experience.
- Highly organized, with the ability to prioritise between various competing priorities while maintaining an attention to detail.
- A commitment to Moonshot mission and ethos.
- In addition, we require and will check on candidates' eligibility to work in the US. Candidates will be expected to undertake and pass any relevant security clearance procedures per the needs of clients.

### Desirable:

- Experience working with a startup.
- Knowledge of US employee relations processes and relevant employment legislations.
- Experience working with a company where security threats are common and risks must be managed carefully.
- Experience working for a multinational corporation in a role requiring regular communications with offices in other countries.
